Market Update Onion

- The price of onions in Lasalgaon is decreases and quoted at INR 3,600 per 100 kgs.
- India imposes minimum export price of \$800 per metric ton on export of onions:
 India imposed a minimum export price of \$800 per metric ton on the export of onions until Dec. 31, according to a notification issued by the Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT).
- Government says certain onion consignments can be exported **November 30**: The government clarified onion consignments that have been handed over to the customs authorities and are registered in their systems before October 29 can be exported till November 30. On October 28, the government imposed a minimum export price (MEP) of USD 800 per tonne on onion exports till December 31 this year with a

• Fresh arrivals cause onion prices to cool down in Andhra Pradesh: The onion prices have dropped by INR 1,400 per quintal compared to the last week. Though arrivals at present are sluggish, we are expecting them to increase steadily in coming days.

Potato

- Potato price were steady in Agra market and quoted at INR 820 per 100 kgs.
- The Varanasi airport handled 598 MT of perishable cargo till November 23 against 561 MT last year. With potato exported for the first time from Purvanchal to a Gulf country (United Arab Emirates), Varanasi has achieved a feat as its monthly agricultural exports crossed the 100 metric ton-mark in November. (link)
- 1st batch of potatoes grown in EUP takes off for Gulf: After mango, fresh green vegetables and other agricultural products, now Purvanchal's potatoes are Gulf-bound. The first ever consignment of potatoes grown by the farmers of the region took off for Gulf countries from Varanasi's Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport.
- **Potato prices in Bengal crash due to slack export demand:** Potato prices in West Bengal have currently dropped by around 30 per cent compared with the November-end last year due to lack of export opportunities and early arrival of fresh produce from Jharkhand.
- **Govt gives permission to import 49,755 ton potatoes in 2 days:** The government, over the last two days, has given permission to import 49,755 tons of potatoes. The government gave such permission against 77 applications, according to a press release of the Ministry of Agriculture. Following the permission for allowing import of potatoes given on Monday, permission for importing 49,755 tons of potatoes was given.

Tomato

- Tomato price were increased in Kolar market and quoted at INR 1400 per 100kgs.
- The current price of a box of tomatoes (15 kgs) is just ₹50 120 at the Kolar APMC. Even in Bengaluru markets, tomatoes are costing ₹15 25 per kg, depending on the size of the fruits.
- Bengaluru Tomato price falls to Rs 4 per kg: The supply of tomato to Kolar APMC Market is much higher than the
 demand. Because of this, the price of tomato today has lost its valuei. A kg tomato is being sold at Rs 3 to 4. That
 means a box of fifteen kg tomatoes is selling at around Rs 50 to 80. Traders say that this situation will continue for a
 few more days.




